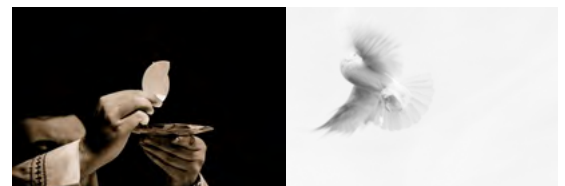
Seder Meal

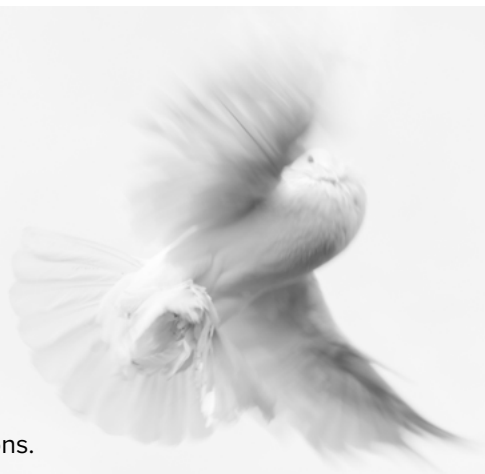
